

Your Upcoming Forest Memorial in Lake Arrowhead

Arrival at the forest

Important things to know

- The entire forest is a non-smoking and non-vaping property. No sparks are allowed in the forest. This includes BBQs, candles, incense sticks and burning of sage. Before traveling to the forest, ensure that your vehicle is not dragging chains that could cause sparks. When you arrive, park in designated parking places only and avoid driving over grasses or underbrush. Fire safety violations can result in fines of up to \$5,000 from the U.S. Forest Service.
- There are no restrooms in the forest, but our team is available to escort you and your guests to facilities at Pinecrest that we can use.
- If you drive a low clearance vehicle, such as a sports car or motorcycle, please reach out to our team ahead of time to coordinate where to park.

What to expect

Weather can change suddenly in the forest – we recommend layering with a warm jacket and long pants and wearing comfortable, closed-toe shoes as the forest trails can be wet and steep in some places.

After your group gathers, we'll begin by gently combining your loved one's ashes with native forest soil. You're welcome to observe or participate as you wish.

We'll then make our way to the memorial tree. Walking sticks, and UTV are available upon request.

At the tree, the memorial will last about 30–60 minutes. Benches will be available, and guests are invited to help spread ashes and sow native wildflower seeds. You'll have private time at the tree before we conclude.

Afterward, you're welcome to explore the forest.
